- **Dr. Kaisa Huhta** is a Professor of European Law with a specialisation in energy law at the University of Eastern Finland and the Co-Director of the Center for Climate Change, Energy, and Environmental Law (CCEEL). She is also a part-time professor at the European University Institute, the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Energy and Natural Resources Law and an expert member of the Finnish Market Court.
- **Dr. Seita Vesa** is a Professor of Environmental Law, with a focus on sustainability transformation, at the University of Eastern Finland's Center for Climate Change, Energy, and Environmental Law (CCEEL). At UEF Law School, Professor Vesa serves as the Head of Law School. In addition, they are affiliated as a Principal Researcher at the Finnish Environment Institute's Climate Solutions Unit (SYKE).

The relationship between energy law, environmental law and climate law is becoming increasingly dynamic as legal systems respond to the accelerating energy transition, climate objectives and evolving geopolitical realities. While these fields share common goals and often reinforce one another, recent developments have also revealed tensions and friction, such as the friction between the acceleration of renewable energy deployment and existing environmental and procedural safeguards, demonstrating how legal systems institutionalise stability and prevent transformative change towards democratically agreed goals. This presentation reviews selected contemporary trends and regulatory developments that illustrate the interactions among these branches of law and their underlying foundational principles and assumptions. The discussion aims to highlight key challenges and emerging patterns without presupposing definitive solutions, providing a basis for broader reflection on the evolving legal landscape.
